In September 1964, Shirley was offered a position as an associate, and thus became the first female associate at Barnes & Thornburg and at any other major law firm in the state. In 1971, Shirley became the first woman to be named a partner in a large Indiana law firm. She continued to blaze a trail in her work at Barnes & Thornburg and in the legal community when, in 1998, she became the first women president of the Indiana Bar Foundation.

Shirley died in 2003, but has remained an important part of Barnes & Thornburg's history as a leading Indiana and national firm. Join Shirley's family members and colleagues as we honor her legacy and other prominent women lawyers and judges.
