Companies qualify for the program, which was instituted in 1976, if they have a Minnesota presence and contribute cash or in-kind donations, including pro bono services and volunteerism.

Barnes & Thornburg increased attorney involvement in pro bono work to more than 90 percent in 2018 and more than doubled per attorney pro bono hours. Additionally, Minneapolis Mayor Jacob Frey recognized the firm as a “Leading Law Firm” in Minneapolis for its efforts and commitment to provide services to low-income clients facing eviction.

This latest recognition builds on several other accolades the firm has

received in recent years, including as a 2018 Best Places to Work honoree by the Minneapolis/St. Paul Business Journal, a leadership award from Minnesota Women Lawyers and being named by Minnesota Business Magazine as one of the 100 best companies to work for.
